COVID Update:

Dear parents we are moving to our Phase 2!

I think I can speak for all of us in saying we are ready for all of this to be over. We are also trying to be intentional about moving forward. Thank you for all of your support through Phase 1. I know that not everyone agrees with our precautions and some wish we had more, but I appreciate your support as we are moving forward.

With flu season approaching we are hoping that our current precautions will help to mitigate the spread of flu and strep throat in our school community.

2 Timothy 1:7 says "For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind." We are not bowing to fear, but we are trying to make decisions based on insights from experts and trying to make wise decisions. I really appreciate your prayer as we try to find the right balance.

Here are a few of the positives-

- We have noticed that we have not had the normal number of stomach issues with our students that we have at the beginning of each school year.
- We have been able to minimize the number of students that had to be quarantined by following our protocols
- I have also heard how several people have gotten closer to God through all of this! Please keep those praises coming in.

Masks - Please remember to wash your masks often. There are valid concerns about students using masks without cleaning them.

Florida at Phase 3 - I must say I really appreciate Governor DeSantis. On Friday he announced that the State was moving to phase 3. He further explained that this meant that in general restaurants, theaters, bars and other businesses could move to 100% capacity. That local governments could not restrict capacity to less than 50%.

Businesses could impose their own restrictions based on their comfort level. Also, that local governments cannot fine for not wearing masks.

In that press release he did not mention anything with regards to schools.

He also mentioned that we need to protect our most vulnerable population – those that are over 70.

We do have some of our school community that go home to family members that are in that vulnerable population. This has caused some justified concern for some of those families. So, we want to keep them in mind as we make decisions.

Putnam County percentage of positive tests has been much better recently. One day it was around 2%! We are continuing to watch this as an indicator of progress around us. It is a real blessing to have the Health Department and EOC working with us.
